Terms and Conditions: The Small Print

Places on the "Introduction to Ground Source Heating and Cooling" short course are limited to approx. 28. Places will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis and will only be reserved for participants on receipt of a course application form and payment of the course fee.

When the capacity of the course has been filled, any further applications or enquiries received will be placed on a waiting list. Places will then be offered to applicants on the waiting list in the event of cancellations on a first-come, first-served basis. No payment will be required by participants on the waiting list until the availability of a place has been confirmed.

In the event that a participant finds it necessary to cancel their attendance, a refund of the course fee will be offered for cancellations notified up to and including the 5th May 2008, subject to the deduction of a £45 administration charge. Cancellations received following 5th May 2008 will not receive a refund of the course fee [*unless* this be at the discretion of the organiser in the event that the course is full and alternative participants are available on the waiting list. In this case also, any refund will be subject to the deduction of a £45 administration charge]. Alternatively, in the event of cancellation, a participant may transfer his or her place to another representative of their organisation, at no charge.

Short courses organised by small consultancy enterprises, such as this, are naturally vulnerable to circumstances which affect the availability of the lecturers.
